Crime Prevention Design Strategies will be discussed for parks, schools, high-rise buildings, and various kinds of residential developments. The course covers CPTED Strategies and Concepts pertaining to Lighting, Fencing, Landscaping, Planning & Zoning, Overlay Districts, Site Plan Review & Report Writing. Practical exercises include a Neighborhood Design Charrette, Site Plan Review, and a CPTED Field Assessment with a team Presentation. At the end of the course the participants take the first of two exams required to earn the CPD. This course will highlight the developing influence in the architecture and design of various facilities with a goal of preventing crime and reducing law enforcement calls for service.
