Description: This 3-day course is designed to give the investigator or supervisor who has been assigned to Internal Affairs duties a comprehensive overview of the organization and design of Internal Affairs investigations. This course should be attended by anyone supervising Internal Affairs investigations or assigned, full-time or occasionally, to investigate complaints of misconduct. This course covers the intersection of POST decertification investigations and departmental administrative investigations. Procedural and legal mandates for such investigations make this course a must for all first line supervisors!

This course was developed and is taught by highly trained, experienced investigators and Internal Affairs commanders. A practitioner's approach is taken in delivering this curriculum in a clear, reality-based manner.
